About the company

The challenges of climate change and creating a sustainable society are enormous, yet bring with them a great opportunity to work together. Renewable energy is part of the solution and there is a growing movement of communities that have come together to make local renewable energy supplies a reality.

Kennet Community Energy Limited (**KCEL**) is an Industrial & Provident Society (IPS) developing renewable energy resources for the benefit of the communities in north and east Wiltshire. Our vision is to create a community-owned and financially sustainable enterprise which will make a major contribution to local, renewable energy generation.

Members' investment will not only fund a growing portfolio of renewable energy projects, but also contribute to a Community Fund that will initiate additional low carbon projects.

Renewable energy projects

Over the next few years we aim to install initially solar PV and biomass technologies but do not rule out deploying other technologies such as anaerobic digesters and small hydroelectric schemes.

Our first development project is a solar PV deployment at the Wadworth Brewery Visitor Centre in Devizes. **KCEL** is also seeking to install renewable energy in community premises such as schools, leisure centres and care homes giving them protection against rapidly rising energy prices.

Community Fund



The Community Fund will be established to invest in new, low carbon projects in north and east Wiltshire. It will derive the bulk of its funding from surplus income generated from the activities of **KCEL**. It will aim to initiate projects that focus upon reducing carbon emissions. These projects would not only be in the field of clean energy generation, but could also encompass other spheres of local activity such as housing insulation, transport and food production.
